

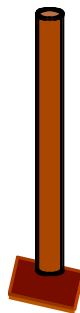
Poles in cement

A useful addition to any early childhood classroom which are used for event based play activities, hanging signs as trees and for anything the students can imagine

Materials

- Broom or mop handles (these can be painted if desired)
- Large tins such as baby food tins
- Quick setting cement
- Small pieces of wood
- Hooks
- Hammer and nails

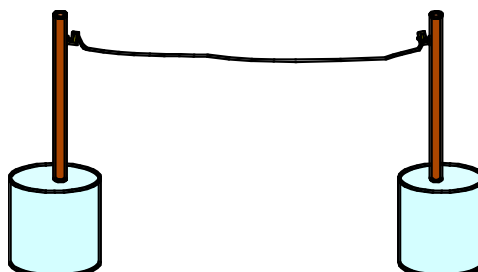
1. Nail pieces of wood on the base of the broom handles. This prevents them coming out of the cement later on.



2. Place the broom handle into a tin.

3. Fill with quick drying cement.

4. When finished place hooks into the poles as required.



5. They can be used to support dowels between them allowing students to construct their own play areas.
